### **Geneva and Cern - July 2019**

Following our successful 2017 trip to Geneva & Cern, we are excited to be able to run the trip again to support our curriculum in Physics, Science, Technology and Languages and to provide students with an enhanced learning experience. The trip will be of particular interest to those studying astronomy and those planning to study maths or physics post 16.

Here are the key details about the planned trip:

- 3 days and 2 nights
- Departs on Monday 15th July
- Returns on Wednesday 17 July - times to be confirmed
- The cost of the trip will be £370 ( max) per student, numbers dependent
- This price includes:
  - Return flight from Manchester to Geneva including all airport taxes
  - Transfer and all transport in Geneva
  - Half-board accommodation; Geneva Youth Hostel
  - Group travel insurance – NST 24hr emergency contact service whilst on tour
  - Trips to Cern & the Large Hadron Collider, The Red Cross Museum & the History of Science Musuem

In addition to the tour cost your child may wish to bring some additional spending money.

We will also require each student to provide:

- A current passport
- An EHI card
- Details of any specific requirements so that arrangements may be made

To secure a place for your child on this trip a non-refundable deposit of £100 is required, along with the completed permission slip by Monday July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Further payments can be made in the new academic year. Clearly if the trip does not go ahead your deposit will be refunded. As this trip is not a compulsory part of the school curriculum, we are unfortunately unable to provide any assistance with the cost. We do our very best to keep costs to a minimum for all of the trips that we plan.

The trip is booked through WST Travel, the UKs leading educational travel company for schools with over 300 years' combined experience. They will work closely with us during the whole tour planning process to ensure that your child will get the very best travel experience whilst away.
