### **Football Tour to Holland Easter 2018**

I am writing to confirm the final arrangements for our departure to Limburg, Holland. We will meet at school at **5:00am**. I appreciate that it is an early morning start however, it is important that we leave on time. When your child arrives, they should register with their assigned teacher and hand in the following to them:

- Any medication
- €10 deposit for the accommodation in a labelled envelope

The itinerary has been confirmed as the following:

#### **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> March**

- Meet at school at 5:00am
- Depart no later than 5:30am
- Eurotunnel crossing 11:50am

#### **Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> March**

- SportsSchool for training and matches

#### **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> March**

- Eftelling theme park excursion

#### **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> March**

- PSV Eindhoven stadium tour
- Eurotunnel crossing 16:20pm (local time)
- Return to school approx. 21:00pm

Can I also take this opportunity to remind you that there is restricted space in the hold of the coach for luggage so pack sensibly! Each pupil is limited to one sports bag/small case for the hold and a small bag or rucksack for carry on. Items of clothing that you should include in your packing are:

- Full Chapel-en-le-Frith High School PE kit
- Shin pads
- Sports clothes for training
- Wash bag with toiletries
- Towels (none are provided at Center Parcs)
- Swimming shorts/ trunks
- Footwear (most of the football will be on 3G pitches with some matches on grass)
- Waterproof jacket
- Leisure wear including clothes for a range of temperatures
- Water bottle
- Sun tan lotion and sunglasses (just in case)
- Approx. €100 spending money (must have money for lunch)

On arrival at Center Parcs, room keys will be distributed to pupils in reception (two per villa), along with one swimming pool entry card per person. The swimming pool card is required for entry into the Aqua Mundo. If the card is lost, replacement cards are available from reception but at an additional cost. Students may wish to purchase WiFi at a cost of €5 for 60 minutes, €15 for 4 devices for 1 day, €25 for 4 devices for 4 days.
