Dear Parent

Year 10 residential 13 – 17 March 2017

We are excited to announce we are organising a 5-day residential trip at the Kingswood Centre, Dearne Valley in March 2017. The focus of the residential will be 'Life Skills', giving the students the opportunity to demonstrate and develop their self care skills, team building, money handling, etc, and enabling us to make informed assessments of the students' needs for future planning.

The trip will be from **Monday 13 - 17 March 2017**, with a provisional itinerary as follows:

- Monday: Travel in Minibus to Kingswood Centre, Dearne Valley, unpack and relaxation, 2 activities led by staff at the centre followed by dinner and an evening activity.
- Tuesday: Breakfast, morning activities led by instructors at the centre, lunch, afternoon activities led by instructors, dinner and relaxation followed by a team building exercise.
- Wednesday: Breakfast, morning activities led by instructors at the centre, lunch, afternoon activities led by instructors, dinner and relaxation followed by an evening activity.
- Thursday: Breakfast, morning activities led by instructors at the centre, lunch, afternoon activities led by instructors, dinner and relaxation followed by evening entertainment.
- Friday: Breakfast, morning activity led by instructor, lunch, pack up and return to school for 3pm.

For parents who are new to Kingswood, they are a leading residential activity centre provider, responsible for delivering safe and rewarding educational programmes to over 130,000 children every year. By combining many National Curriculum-linked modules with thrilling outdoor and indoor adventure activities, this trip is sure to provide your child with a wealth of new experiences outside of the classroom.

The total cost of the visit will be £168 and includes return travel by minibus, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities. If your son/daughter is entitled to pupil premium funding the school will contribute 50% of the cost of the trip.

The first non-refundable deposit of £48.00 is required by **Monday 10th October 2016**, with subsequent payments due as follows:
