Year 7 Castleton trip - Geography and History

Learning outside the classroom is an essential aspect of the school curriculum, giving students real and relevant experiences in their own locality to promote understanding. In light of this, we have planned a trip to Castleton for the whole of Year 7 on the dates highlighted below. As you can see, we will be taking two teaching groups on each of the dates listed:

7H & 7L	Monday 16th October
7C & 7E	Tuesday 17th October
7F & 7S	Wednesday 18th October
7R	Thursday 19th October

Please could you make a note of the day of the visit for your son/daughter to avoid confusion.

Sensible clothing, sturdy footwear such as walking boots or wellies, and a waterproof jacket are **essential**. Students are required to bring a packed lunch, drinks and a fully equipped pencil case as they will be completing activities including workbooks and sketching. Students may also bring a small amount of spending money for souvenirs if they so wish, (maximum £5.00). If your child is entitled to a free school meal they can collect a packed lunch from the restaurant before school.

The students will be working in supervised groups and will engage in a tour of Treak Cliff Cavern and a walk on local footpaths from Treak Cliff to Castleton itself. Students will also visit Peveril Castle where they will complete a workbook.

We aim to be back at school by 3.00pm to facilitate usual end of day arrangements.

As this is an essential curriculum trip we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£12.00** to cover the cost of the coach and admission to the castle and cavern. We regret to say that should insufficient contributions be received the trip may not go ahead. Payments for trips may be made either in cash or by cheque or by using Parent Pay.

As this trip is a compulsory part of the school curriculum you will not need to make a contribution to its cost if your child is eligible under the government's Pupil Premium scheme. If your child is eligible for this help you will have been informed, by letter, at the start of this school year.
