


## Resetting Go 4 Schools Password – Students and parents.

To reset your password, go to the school website and click on the link on right hand side menu for either, 'Go 4 Schools Parents' or 'Go 4 Schools Students', see below:

**If you are having problems logging on, please contact your school.**



In the email address box, add your school email if you are a student or if you are a parent the email address you have given to school as part of your contact details.

Then press the 'send password reset link'.

An email will be sent to your email account. Open the email and click on the link (or copy and paste into the address bar in your browser).

You will be taken to a web page that will ask you to reset your password. For students, I strongly suggest you choose a password that you can remember and keep a record of it somewhere other than your phone!

You will now be able to login on your browser and on the app.
