

School Uniform

We want our pupils to wear their school uniform with pride. We believe that our uniform is practical, reasonably priced and easily obtainable. All pupils are expected to wear full, smart uniform.

General Uniform

- Plain, nylon, **tailored** black school trousers (with no stretch) or black **knee-length** skirt. Any belts, fastenings or zips **must** be black. Skinny-legged trousers, jeans style, cropped trousers and leggings are **not** permitted.
- Plain black shoes (not boots) - laces and fastenings should be plain black - patches of colour or white on the shoe or sole, are not permitted. High heels, open-toed sandals, slip-ons and fabric “pumps” are also not acceptable.
- Plain black tights or white socks (with skirts).
- Black sweatshirt with school logo.*
- White polo shirt with red stripe on collar and school logo.*

- **No** make up is permitted in Years 7 and 8, discreet make up is permitted in Years 9-11.
- **No** jewellery except one small stud or sleeper earring in each earlobe.
- **No** visible facial or body piercings, (i.e. nose, lip or tongue etc)
- **No** false/gel nails. Only clear, neutral, or very pale pink nail varnish is permitted.

If your child has to attend school in a non-uniform item, please ensure that your child brings in an accompanying note from home.



PE Uniform

Royal blue and white multi-sports top*
Royal blue or white T-shirt with school logo*
Navy shorts
Royal blue football socks for football and rugby and blue or white sports socks for other activities
Trainers
Football boots (if participating in football or rugby)

A royal blue sweatshirt is optional with the school logo*. Pupils may not wear any other sweatshirt in PE.

In cold weather, for outdoor activities, pupils may also be permitted to wear tracksuit bottoms. These should be plain navy blue or black.

The PE department also offer a ‘hoodie’ for use in extra-curricular clubs and matches. Further details are available from the department.

Trainers must be worn when playing on the Astroturf. Pupils must change into a separate pair of trainers to go on the Astroturf in order to prevent sand from being trodden into the carpets in school.
