

Homework Projects Schedule 2018 – 19

Please find attached the homework schedule for this year for students in years 7 and 8.

- All students in years 7 and 8 have a weekly core homework set in maths, English, science and modern foreign languages of approximately 45 minutes.
- All other subjects set 2 week project style homeworks according to the calendar below.
- These subjects may **also** set short homework tasks as and when required, for example research, preparation for tests, extending classwork tasks. In line with the move towards a linear examination system some of the set homework will be designed to encourage students to review, revise and revisit material covered in lessons as part of a five year 'learning journey.'
- Each project has an approximate 4 hour time expectation with differentiated outcomes. Students will be told the assessment criteria when the piece is set.
- All homework tasks are available on ShowMyHomework and subject teachers will provide paper copies of tasks where necessary.

Homework in year 9

- All students have a weekly core homework set in maths, English, modern foreign languages and science of approximately 45 mins to 1 hour per subject.
- All other subjects set homework of approximately one hour per fortnight. This may be in the form of a number of short homeworks or more extended pieces of work.
- Work will start to reflect the style of learning expected at GCSE level and will require students to work with independence. In line with the move towards a linear examination system, some of the set homework will be designed to encourage students to review, revise and revisit material covered in lessons as part of a five year 'learning journey.'
- All students are expected to extend their learning through further research, use of 'phone apps online practice and reading.
- All homework tasks are available on ShowMyHomework and subject teachers will provide paper copies of tasks where necessary.

Homework in years 10 and 11

- All subjects set regular homework and this will encompass a wide variety of tasks and activities.
- Staff will be fair and proportionate in the amount of homework given and set achievable deadlines.
- Set homework should be regarded as the basic minimum expectation. All students are expected to extend their learning through further research, use of 'phone apps and online practice and reading. Some of the set homework will be designed to encourage students to review, revise and revisit material covered in lessons.
- All homework will be set using ShowMyHomework and subject teachers will provide paper copies of tasks where necessary.
