A key part of our approach to supporting your child in achieving their challenging Aim High grades is to formally assess their progress at regular intervals, for year 7 students this will happen during an examination fortnight beginning **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2017**.

During week one of this fortnight all paper based exams be assessed through examinations in the main school hall, details of which are outlined in the schedule below. This setting will begin to get students used to the formal exam requirements and protocols which are required from all students at GCSE. More practical based subjects will be completing their formal exams during their timetabled lessons during week two; please encourage your child to write these additional exams into the schedule below.

Year 7 student's homework over the coming weeks is to revise thoroughly in the preparation for these formal assessments; teachers will be providing students with specific guidance regarding their revision. The result of these assessments will be published to parents in the form of 'Assessment two – Exams' report.
